PROGRAM

Leadership Calaveras is a 10-month commitment which provides participants with an educational experience to increase awareness and knowledge of vital organizations in Calaveras County through hands on activities, tours, and panel discussions. These sessions are designed to be interactive and participants are expected to share their experiences and viewpoints.

Participants will meet once a month, usually every 3rd Tuesday, at selected venues throughout Calaveras County and surrounding areas.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

Class size is limited to 15 individuals, not all applicants will be accepted. A diverse class encourages great discussion and the selection committee works hard to assemble a participant group that represents the Calaveras County community. Candidates not selected in a given year are strongly encouraged to re-apply.

APPLICANTS MUST SHOW:

- Potential or demonstrated leadership abilities
- Community interest and involvement
- Desire to assume expanded leadership responsibility

PARTICIPATION

Full participation of the scheduled program days is essential to the Leadership Calaveras experience. Class members are expected to arrive on time and remain with the class for the entire session. The 2-day orientation and teambuilding session is mandatory for those selected to participate in the program. During the orientation, participants will receive all Leadership Calaveras materials and class schedule. To graduate, participants are required to attend 7 out of the 10 sessions, contribute to class and project discussions, and turn in completed assignments by the respective dates.

Because of the time commitment, it is vital that Leadership Calaveras participants have the support of their employer. Applicants are encouraged to discuss the application process, program cost and time commitment with their employer prior to submitting the application.
