If Online by Email: Email video(s) to calaverascommunitytv@gmail.com . Video submittal(s) must have program title and entrant name.

If by Mail: Send a copy of the video(s) on a USB thumb drive to P.O. Box 244, San Andreas, CA. 95249 with a check or proof of PayPal payment. Video submittal must have program title and entrant name.

If In Person: Bring a copy of the video(s) on a USB thumb drive to Paul A.E. Moeller Calaveras County Public Access TV Studio 429 E. St. Charles Street, San Andreas, CA 95249. Video submittal must have program title and entrant name.

The Love Your Pet Video Contest is open **only** to residents of Calaveras and Amador Counties.

The Love Your Pet Video Contest welcomes non-commercial videos from media professionals, nonprofessionals, and youth. Entrants must submit their entries between January 25, 2023 and February 1, 2023.

The Love Your Pet Video Contest Awards Ceremony and Screening will be held on Saturday, February 11, 2023, from 4 to 6 p.m. at the Paul A.E. Moeller Calaveras County Public Access Television Studio.

How to Enter

Entries may be submitted online, by mail or in person.

Online submittals, may be made through email or by URL. If by email, send video attachment to calaverascommunitytv@gmail.com. If by URL, link to your entry via Youtube, Vimeo or other permalinked video hosting web service. Make sure your link is set to public view. If judges are unable to view your entry, you may be disqualified.

Send mail submittals on a USB thumb drive to Calaveras Community TV, P.O. Box 244, San Andreas, Ca. 95249. In person submittals bring video(s) on a USB thumb drive Paul A.E. Moeller Calaveras County Public Access TV Studio 429 E. St. Charles Street, San Andreas, CA 95249

Video Length

Video length needs to be between 15 seconds and 60 seconds. Make sure to label your video(s) the same name that is on your registration form

Label Your Entry

Each video file entry must be clearly labeled with: Program title and Entrant name

Entry Fees

\$10 per entry. One entry per category a maximum of 3 entries total.

Payment

Payment must be submitted in full at time of entry. You may pay by check or online through PayPal. If paying by check, make check payable to: CCTV. If paying online, pay through PayPal to calaverascommunitytv@gmail.com in note section put name of video and entrant name, then submit video to calaverascommunitytv@gmail.com. All payments must be in U.S. dollars. If paying by check, please enclose your payment and registration form with your USB thumb drive. If paying through PayPal please submit your video entry and registration form calaverascommunitytv@gmail.com. No refunds will be issued once an entry is submitted.

Category Entries

Love Your Pete Video Contest has 3 categories of video entries, they are “Cutest Pet Video”, “Funniest Pet Video” and “Overall Pet Video”. Entrants may enter 1 video per category for a total of 3 video entries You must pay and entry fee for each entry. One check, or online payment may be sent for the total amount of all required fees. each category entry will incur a \$10 entry fee.

Judging

Video entries will be judged by community members affiliated with media and/or media production. A panel of 3 judges will review entries and make final decisions on winners.

Winners will be determined by: (1) how well the entry represents the qualities appropriate for its category; (2) the extent to which the video(s) develops and maintains viewer interest; (3) the unique or creative way the video(s) approaches its subject and (4) technical competence.

Disqualification

Entries will be disqualified if:

1. The video entry is not viewable: audio is inaudible, video is unstable or for any other technical reason. Judges will attempt to view on at least 2 machines before disqualifying.

2. An entry clearly violates a specific requirement of the category in which it is entered.

No refunds will be made for any entry that is disqualified or if any other error is made by the producers or submitters of any entries. A decision by the judging panel to disqualify an entry is final.
